CONSULTATION GUIDELINES

Screen your clients suitability for colouring service by asking the following questions. If it is your salon guests first visit for a color service carry out an AAT as per the manufacturer instructions in the product leaflet. If your color guest has used this product in your salon within the last 6 months follow these screening questions for safety.

- ▶ Has your salon guest ever had any allergic reactions to hair colouring products?
- ▶ Does your salon guest have a sensitive, itchy or damaged scalp?
- ▶ Has your salon guest ever had a reaction to a temporary 'black henna' tattoo, any other type of skin tattoo or permanent make-up?
- ▶ Is this the first time they have visited your salon as a colour client or are they changing shade or brand?
- ▶ Has it been more than 6 months since your salon guest last had a colour service in your salon?
- ▶ Is it more than 6 months since your salon guest last had a skin allergy test?
- ▶ Has your salon guest had any type of skin tattoo including henna or permanent make-up since their last colour service?
- ▶ Has your salon guest had any type of an allergic reaction since their last colouration?
- ▶ Is your salon guest taking oral or topical steroids or other immunosuppressant medicines ?
- ▶ is your salon guest preganant or breast feeding ?
